**Please note: Course registration needs to be completed in the individual student account. Course registration is not available through the parent portal.**

### **Logging on Through Individual Student Account**

1. After logging in, click the tab "My Info."
2. On the side column, click "Requests."
3. Click the "Select" button next to the subject to choose an elective and/or make a change to the recommended course.
4. Check the box next to the courses.
5. If you would like to leave a note for a guidance counselor, type in your message under "Notes for Counselor."
6. Once completed with all selections, click "post" at the bottom of the page.
